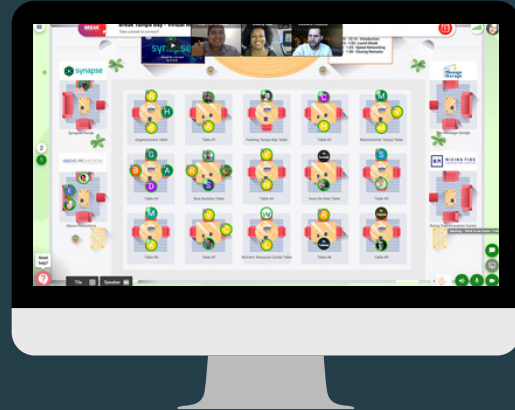

## USING LUNCHPOOL

To login to the event, click the link emailed to you on Friday. Your email address is your username, and the password is 'NIS2020'.

Once you're in the room you can join a table just like an in-person event by double clicking on an open chair at the table. As with Zoom, you can turn your microphone & camera on and off at your table.



During panels and sessions, you'll automatically see the speaker and your camera will be turn off and your microphone will be muted. You can ask questions and talk with others via chat. There are also four side lounges you can visit to have side-discussions with other participants.
