The next set, questions 11-18 are relational questions, meaning that the respondent will answer each question about the organizations they selected in Q10.

Q11-12: We have the relational questions listed here, and they all can be modified. However, there are several options/variations for the content of these questions. At the end of this table are additional options to choose from (in blue text). In total, we recommend only choosing a total of 1 additional relational question (in addition to q11, q12, we recommend only one other as the 3rd option, which will need to be inserted as Q19).

Questions 13-18 are also relational, but they assess the content and type of relationship between two partners, by providing ratings on the quality of relationships in terms of Value and Trust. Questions 13-15 are three measures of Value and questions 16-18 are three measures of Trust. The wording of Q13-18 can be slightly modified for your network, but the context cannot change. These are trademark PARTNER questions and usually yield the most useful data so we recommend keeping them in tact as much as possible
